## **Participant Information & Guidelines**

- 1. Non-profit groups no charge. For profit groups \$25.00 fee.
- 2. The festival begins at 3:00 pm. Food Vendors must be set-up and ready to begin at 3:00 pm.
- 3. Woburn Common will close to traffic at 1:00pm. Please plan set-up of booths accordingly.
- 4. Each vendor is allotted 8-12 ft for booths. Space is determined by the number of vendors participating. We will do our best to let each group know the booth size in advance.
- 5. Vendors are responsible for bringing their own tables, pop up tents or set-up materials.
- 6. Food Vendors must have hand sanitizer at their station.
- 7. Each vendor will sell different food products in order for the event to be financially successful for everyone.
- 8. Food service gloves must be worn when having direct contact with food products.
- 9. Hand washing stations will be located behind the food vendors. These stations are for food workers only.
- 10. Electricity will not be provided to vendors. Generators are allowed. Plan accordingly.
- 11. Individual table raffles are not allowed. If your group would like to donate a raffle to The Festival on The Common Committee that would be greatly appreciated. Proceeds from our raffles go towards the Festival on the Common.
